CHILDREN'S HOME + AID HEALTHY FAMILIES ILLINOIS PROGRAM RECEIVES DEKALB COMMUNITY FOUNDATION GRANT

DEKALB (November 23, 2011) – On November 10, 2011, the Sycamore office of Children's Home + Aid was awarded a grant for \$1713 by the DeKalb County Community Foundation. Eileen Liezert, Vice President of the Northern Region, and Peggy Franklin, Director of Adoptions and Child and Family Counseling will accept the award on behalf of the Healthy Families Illinois program in the Sycamore office of Children's Home + Aid at 1:00 PM on December 2, 2011 from Bran Brown, one of the Directors of the DeKalb County Community Foundation. The grant will be used to purchase a lap top computer and interactive software computer programs to teach parents at risk of abuse or neglect. The interactive computer software published by The Learning Seed focuses on educating parents about children's physical, cognitive and social emotional development, teaches parents how to thoroughly baby proof their homes, and offers parents a way to test their knowledge of child development. Children's Home + Aid graciously accepts the grant and looks forward to using the software with the families in DeKalb County as they learn new techniques in parenting and gain more understanding of the importance of the stages in child development.
